Meeting patient expectations for immediate fixed restorations and superior final outcomes can be challenging. Many times, the two cannot coexist. Is there a strategy that can solve both goals? Patient demands of immediacy and esthetics add to the clinical challenge. What is the best way to move a patient from existing dentition through transitional temporization?

This course will introduce the clinician to best practice principles for use of immediate, transitional, or delayed provisional implant restorations thereby preserving hard and soft t issues. Live patient clinical treatment will outline the restorative pathway for developing and delivering exceptional immediate function provisional restorations.



Dr. McFadden lectures nationally and internationally on dental implant treatment. He received his dental degree from the University of Pittsburgh School of Medicine and his Certificate of Prosthodontics from Baylor College of Dentistry. He was awarded Board Certification by the American Board of Prosthodontics in 1995 and by the

American Board of Oral Implantology in 2012. After nine years as a professor at UT Southwestern Medical Center, where he established the Dental Implant Center at Southwestern, Dr. McFadden opened his private practice and continuing education center at McFadden Dental Implant Center in 2002 in Dallas, Texas.



Dr. Daniel Tan received his dental degree from the National University of Singapore. After several years of practice, he then went on to obtain his specialty certification in Advanced Prosthodortics from the University of Southern California. Dr. Tan is currently in full time private practice at the McFadden Dental Implant Center where

he works with Dr. McFadden in the management of patients undergoing complex full-mouth rehabilitation. As part of the team, he provides prosthodontic support, aided by his keen eye for detail, knowledge of dental literature, and commitment to providing the very best treatment for his patients.
